INSTRUMENTAL MUSIC PROGRAM

🎵 INTRODUCTION:

For most people music is an integral part of life. All students can derive considerable fulfilment and enjoyment from music education, not only those who show particular talent. Music programs that provide opportunities for students to be actively involved in a wide range of musical experiences are more likely to develop in the students an understanding of, and a sensitivity towards music, giving them a better chance to find meaning in music and become aware of the value of music in their own lives and the lives of others.

🎵 LESSONS:

Students attend one lesson each week, which is rotated throughout the term to have minimal effect on classroom learning. It is School policy that each student sees the teacher of the subject they are missing before attending an Instrumental Music Lesson. Teachers have access to the lesson timetable and usually assist students with work when they have taken the time to see the teacher before attending an Instrumental Music lesson. Catching up lesson work in one's own time is a small price to pay for the opportunity to learn a musical instrument.

Tuition on a second instrument is possible if a student is doing well on their primary instrument. Learning a second instrument is negotiated with parents but is allowed at the discretion of the Instrumental Music teacher as availability of instruments, balance of band instrumentation and student timetables must be considered.

🎵 REHEARSALS:

All Instrumental Music students are expected to be active members of either the Concert Band or String Ensemble.

When beginners reach a suitable level they will be invited to join an ensemble. Rehearsals are every Tuesday during the lunch hour.
