Welcome to 2023

The first tuckshop day for 2023 will be on TUESDAY JANUARY 31.

Each Tuesday, tuckshop will be available for students to buy their lunches.

All students are to order both big and afternoon lunches. This includes home bake, drinks etc. Everything your child wishes to purchase is to be ordered.

Please order big and afternoon lunches on separate bags ie. 2 bags per student.

All students are to order their chips and drinks with their big lunch order.

Printed paper bags (\$1.80/ 50 bags) are available from the office which makes it easy for parents to fill out. It would also be helpful if the correct change is with the order as younger children do not realise that they should receive change with their order.

Please no plastic bags or alfoil; money can be put in a zip bag or envelope (no staples). It is quite time consuming when trying to organise the morning and get the orders underway if I struggle with getting money out of cling wrap, stapled envelopes, or alfoil.

HOME BAKING

With the support of parents who supply Home Baking the tuckshop can give children that extra treat. Please indicate on the attached form if you can help and return to the school by **Monday 6th February 2023.**

A roster will then be sent home so you will know when to provide Home Bake.

Home Bake is provided at second break for the children who order it. For those parents supplying Home Bake could you supply 1 – 1 ½ dozen of either of the following – small /patty / cupcakes - pikelets – muffins - slice – or a large slab cake. You may wish to supply a combination – slice, cake, pikelets / muffins, patty cakes.

Only one parent is generally rostered on each week. Home Bake can be left at the tuckshop or sent to school with your child when you are rostered on. Your empty containers will be sent home with your child in the afternoon.

If you are unable to assist with home bake you may like to make a small donation towards the tuckshop as your contribution.
